



CORE & ELECTIVE VACCINES WHICH ONES AND WHEN?



DA2PP / DHPP = distemper, adenovirus (hepatitis), parvovirus, parainfluenza. Recommended for all puppies.

Booster every 3-4 weeks until minimum 16 weeks of age (typically at 8, 12, & 16 weeks), then repeat one year later.



<u>Legally required</u>. Rabies is a deadly disease! Given once at either the 12 or **16 week visit**, repeated one year later, and then every three years thereafter.



Bacterial infection spread by **wildlife urine** (rats, skunks, raccoons, etc.). Affects the liver and kidneys, can also infect humans. **Condo-dwelling dogs and hunting dogs alike can be at risk**. Previously considered elective, but is now considered a core vaccine as of 2024. Two boosters given 3-4 weeks apart (typically at **12 & 16 weeks**), then once annually.



Causes kennel cough, a highly contagious **respiratory infection**. If infected, healthy dogs usually recover within 2 weeks; immune compromised dogs may develop complications like pneumonia. **Optional** vaccine, based on lifestyle and risk factors. One booster given at **any time**.
